It was finished, according to Mozart's own catalogue, on March 2, 1786, two months prior to the premiere of his opera, *Le nozze di Figaro*, and some three weeks prior to the completion of his next piano concerto.

The key of A major seems to have had a calming effect on Mozart (think of his Clarinet Quintet and Clarinet Concerto), and this is reflected in the graceful lyricism of the concerto's opening themes. The second movement holds a special place in Mozart's output.
